# Pecoraro knows the possibilities

When Salvatore Pecoraro's constructed models for painting became works of art in their own right, the Chicago-born California artist added a new dimension to his art. Pecoraro's abstract "Prismatic Constructions" can be seen through June 15 in the Klein Gallery, 356 W. Huron.

Softly modulated colors airbrushed on styrene panels are changed by triangles, rectangles and curving shapes of acrylic plastic, often resting on narrow shelves of that plastic. They sometimes cast multiple shadows and refractions of their edges on the background panels.

Pecoraro knows all the possibilities, from simple translucence to the magical transmission of color when the edges of clear acrylic plastic glow with hues painted at their point of juncture with the panels. The results are subtle and changing effects of space in large, carefully balanced compositions of great beauty.
